Radical in its design and look, the Explocat 52 is a genuine all-terrain boat for the seas. With its thermal insulation, central heating and interior helm station, it can venture into the most extreme regions, in complete safety, maintaining high daily averages.


The rigidity that comes with an aluminium structure and the soundproofing virtues of its insulation ensure that this extraordinary catamaran is capable of calm and serene passage-making.



TO HANDLE

SPARCRAFT I


The Explocat 52 has been designed to be easily and safely managed by a short-handed crew. The external helm station on the Explocat 52 is fitted with a pivoting wheel steering system, allowing the helm to be placed either in a low, sheltered position under the coachroof overhang, or high, for manoeuvring and sailing in fine weather.

All the usual sailing manoeuvres are carried out in one place, on the starboard side, behind the helm station, where the ergonomics are perfect, with clutches and winches at just the right height. Headsail halyards, which are handled less frequently, are accessible in the forward cockpit, in a perfectly ergonomic area with a direct view of the mast.









OUTSIDE IN

THE FORWARD COCKPIT EXTENDS THE INTERIOR SPACE TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL LIVING AREA

The Explocat 52 offers an exceptional forward cockpit, directly accessible from inside the nacelle, thanks to a secure watertight door. From the aft cockpit to the forward cockpit, the passage through the interior is all on the same level, through large openings. The outside becomes an extension of the inside.

If you're high-latitude sailing in good weather, the forward cockpit also makes a perfect watchkeeping area among the ice.







INSIDE OUT

Not just space: benefit from the high quality of the interior, equipment and finishes that create a neat and protective atmosphere on board.






A HAVEN OF PEACE, WHEREVER YOU ARE AROUND THE GLOBE

Leave port, leave your obligations, leave everything behind for the duration of your voyage — everything except your comfort.

In the owner's version, the starboard hull is a complete suite. It is independent and bright, offering a large sleeping area, a closet, an office space, a separate toilet and a vast bathroom with double sinks.

You're aboard a thermally and acoustically insulated yacht, designed with meticulous attention to materials and detail. No tricks, no shiny gimmicks, just a fine, subtle design that's soothing when the surrounding nature might be harsh or the conditions challenging.

The port hull has two double cabins, one at either end and a large bathroom in the centre, as well as a laundry and storage area. Other configurations are also possible, with more bathrooms, or even four completely independent double cabins. A workshop can be located forward in the starboard hull and a skipper's cabin to port.
